*****ENTRY RULES****

- 1. All entry blanks and fees must be postmarked by May 5, 2025, or hand delivered by May 10, 2025. Contact Linnea or Freline 808-938-8584 for hand delivery. Entry blanks must be filled out completely with all contact information or the right of a mailed refund or payment is waived.
- 2. All contestants must stop at the entrance gate so attendants may check names on the contestant list. Gate opens at 5:30 am. Gates will close at 7:00 pm, and the arena will be cleared by 8:00 pm.
- 3. FULL PAYMENT MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY BLANK or a \$25 fine will be assessed. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

All fines must be paid in full prior to participation in this rodeo.

4. Contestants must be able to compete on all 3 days!

IF YOU CANNOT COMPETE AT ALL SCHEDULED TIMES (INCLUDING SLACK), DO NOT ENTER!

- 5. #4 Dally: Both partners combined must not exceed #4. Ropers will be using ACTRA Numbers.
- 6. #4.5 Century Roping: Both partners age must equal 100 or more, minimum age 50 years. Both partners combined must not exceed 4.5. Ropers will be using ACTRA Numbers. Call Linnea Botelho if you do not have an ACTRA number.
- 7. Double Mugging: Rope must pass over the calf's head.
- 8. Junior Bull riders: 7 to 12 years. Helmet and safety equipment recommended!
- John Miguel Ranch Saddle Broncs: Regular roping saddle must be used.
- 10. All rough stock events-2 helpers only allowed on bucking chutes per contestant. Helpers must be in proper rodeo attire.
- 11. Wahine Breakaway: Must rope out of Heelers box. Rope must pass over calf's head but catch as catch can.
- 12. Calf scramble: Contestant must provide their own rope. CANNOT ENTER IF CHILD ROPES OFF OF A HORSE
- 13. Sheep Riding: 6 years old or under. Child's weight including all gear must not exceed 50 pounds. Child WILL be weighed before riding.

Helmet recommended. No rigging. (If sheep available)

- 14. Pairing up of partners will not be allowed. Do not leave your partner's name blank.
- 15. ALL CONTESTANTS MUST BE READY TO COMPETE WHEN CALLED UPON. IF CONTESTANTS ARE NOT READY WHEN CALLED, STOCK WILL BE TURNED OUT AND/OR NO TIME WILL BE GIVEN.
- 16. Champion Buckles will be awarded on Monday immediately after the event. Be prepared to accept awards in the arena at this time.
- 17. All around saddles will be based on points. In the case of a tie, a tie breaker will be based on the money won.
- 18. No abuse of livestock in or around the arena will be tolerated. Offenses may result in disqualification.
- 19. Judges decision will be final. NO PROTEST ALLOWED.

Any quarreling, disputes, threats, acts of violence or other disorderly behavior, before, during or after the rodeo on the Honokaa Arena premises involving a contestant or their representative(s) with rodeo officials, parking attendants, security, spectators, or other contestants, may result in the immediate disqualification from all events, forfeiture of prize money and/or eviction from the premises. Appeals should be brought to the direction of Hawaii Saddle Club president, Billy Andrade, his decision is final and cannot be further appealed.

Rodeo Attire

Cowboy hats or the 2025 HSC Caps, Western shirts with full button front or Hawaii Saddle Club 2025 T-shirts (no other T-shirts allowed) must be worn by contestants before, during and after the show, as well as during slack roping. Short sleeves are permitted. NO tennis shoes, NO Cleats.
